General Kiwanis Park Camp Information

- Children must have completed Grade 4 prior to camp.
- Camper to Staff ratio is 8:1.
- Daily swims for both camps. All swim times are supervised by certified lifeguard staff.
- Children should come prepared to spend the day outside - sunscreen, hat, refillable water bottle, raingear, closed toe running shoes, bug spray, bathing suit and towel are essential.
- Supervision times: 8:30 am – 4:30 pm.
- All camps are held at Kiwanis Park, located at 600 Kiwanis Park Drive, Kitchener.
- Register at any City of Kitchener Pool. If you already have an account with the City of Kitchener, register on-line at www.kitchener.ca using the bar codes on the front of this page.
