Application Process

To apply, please submit a proposal to <a>ED@wods.ca that includes the following information,

- Description of the proposed project, including a proposed timeline
- Target demographic of the program (Youth focus heavily preferred)
- Amount requested, and a budget detailing how the funds would be used
- Expected participation numbers
- Intended impact on growing and developing disc sports throughout Waterloo region
- Proposed resources that may be developed to benefit the broader disc sports community

Applications will be reviewed by the WODS Board of Directors at their next meeting after the application is received. Funds will be allocated with the following criteria being considered,

- Anticipated community impact
- Target demographic
- Potential for long term growth and development

Conditions of Funding

Should funding be granted, the following requirements must be met prior to receiving the full amount of funds.

- The project is successfully completed (any major changes to the submitted proposal must be approved by the WODS Board of Directors)
- A blog post summarizing the activity, event, or undertaking is provided, to be posted on the WODS website and social media in order to raise awareness of the growth initiative to the larger community
- A short write-up is provided to the WODS Board of Directors about what was learned from undertaking the project, including what went well and what should be changed next time in order to enable the WODS community to learn from the project
